



Parallel Pen Florals with Monica Winters



We will learn to blend watercolors using the corners of the Parallel Pen 6.0 and to make florals using a circle template to make pencilled dots (worksheet of printed dots will be provided).

Supplies to bring: 6.0 Parallel Pen (Blue cap - cleaned out w/no cartridge) Pencil, Eraser (kneaded or white plastic), Your favorite pan watercolors (such as Prang, Gansi Tambi, colored mica pans, etc.), Small utility brush for stirring watercolors and loading colors onto the Pen, Small Container (or 2) for water, A few paper towels, A thin foam pad or stack of papers for padding your surface.



Art Deco Flowers with Jeri Wright

Art Deco period came about in the 1920's to 1930's. The "Mackintosh Rose" has become world famous for its simple but eye catching design. We will be drawing Mackintosh inspired flowers in this session.


Handouts and worksheet will be provided. Flair 0.7mm felt tip black pen & several colored pencils will be provided for use during class.

Floral Zentangle with Suzanne Holmes



Supplies to bring: Pencil, eraser, 01 black Micron pen

We will use Zentangle elements to create florals to "plant" a garden. We will use shading to give it dimension. A template and shading tool will be provided.





Supplies to bring: Black Micron #01 or 05, watercolor pencils (3-5 in any flower colors & green), round brush #2 or smaller, paper towel

We will have 4 tables that the participants will spend 20 minutes doing handson creating of each floral type before moving to the next table.

Wedge Brush Florals Simplified with June Baty



Learn to make these beautiful petals and leaves using TWO basic strokes. You may surprise yourself. All these colorful flowers at your creative fingertips. So let's have some painting fun!

SUPPLY LIST:

- #8 and #10 wedge brush or which size you have (often called the triangle brush)
- · A couple of tiny round brushes, 3/0 or similar small size for flower centers,
- # 005 and/or # O1 black Micron pen a larger size .5 or .7 might be handy too
- Watercolor paper: Strathmore, Camson or even Arches (scraps for practice)
- Your favorite flower watercolor paints; a couple of green paints for the leaves
- · Small water jar, a few sheets of paper towels, a water spritzer or pipette to wet your paints
- Some good scrap paper for texting paints and combinations
- Pencil, eraser and paper for taking notes, pointed Q-tips if you have them
